

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The Septic Re-Inspection Program

In 2006 the Clean Water Act was established and encompasses the Drinking Water Source Protection Program – via "The Walkerton Inquiry"





The Building Code Act (2012) authorizes municipalities to implement a Discretionary On-Site Sewage System Maintenance Inspection Program.

In 2020, the Township of Severn implemented the Discretionary Sewage System Maintenance Inspection Program (By-law 2020-28).


Discretionary On-Site Sewage System Maintenance Inspection Program



The **Discretionary** On-Site Sewage System Maintenance Inspection Program will apply to all properties serviced by a sewage system and that directly front upon the following waterbodies within the Municipality:

Severn River
Gloucester Pool
Little Lake
Maclean Lake
Matchedash Bay
Lake Couchiching
Lake St. George
Green River
Black River
Sparrow Lake
Tea Lake

^{*} The highlighted bodies of water are the areas that the inspections were conducted in 2024.

Invoicing & Follow-ups

The cost is \$150

2 years old or less will be exempt from program

Deficiencies. The property owner(s) will be notified by mail, and they must take the necessary steps to correct the deficiency within the timeframe stipulated.

- Systems 40 years or older must submit a pump out report from a licensed sewage hauler. (A part of regular maintenance)
- Systems without records are required to get a septic site assessment and a pump out report

All properties are managed in the same manner, but the deficiencies found can be unique to each property.



The Discretionary On-Site Sewage System Maintenance Inspections Program of 2024 consisted of 458 properties, including the 86 exceptions.





Out of all 458 properties inspected within the Discretionary Program, 3 properties had high risk deficiencies noted on site.

2024 - Island - Discretionary

The Discretionary On-Site Sewage System Maintenance Inspections Program of 2024 consisted of 18 properties, including the 1 exceptions.





Out of all 18 properties inspected within the Discretionary Program, 0 properties had high risk deficiencies noted on site.

Full Five Years


The Mandatory & Discretionary On-Site Sewage System Maintenance Inspections Program of the five-year cycle consisted of 2060 properties, including the 283 exceptions.





Septic Permits

Septic permits issued for properties within the Septic Re-Inspection Program. These permits include repairs, tank replacement or new septic.






Since the program started in 2020 a total of 406 septic permits were submitted, 192 were within the septic re-inspection areas.

Enforcement

Type of deficiencies to enforce replacement:

- Illegal Systems (nonconforming to past and/or present standards)
- Failing Septic Beds or Tanks
- Deteriorated Steel Tanks
- Dumping of Greywater and/or Blackwater







Deficiencies Found – Damaged Systems

Large hole from an animal.

Septic Beds overgrown.

Hole in tank lid.



Deficiencies Found – Structures On Septic Bed

Large structures were built on top of the septic bed.







Deficiencies Found – Outdoor Showers/ Sinks









Deficiencies Found – Greywater & Blackwater

- Left Illegal greywater pit.
 Centre Failing bed with leaching effluent.
 Right Greywater Discharge.
